

## The "Baby Welcome Package" of the City of Dessau-Roßlau

A very special welcome for the families of our city!



A new member of the family is about to be born or is already in the world. Families want a good start in life for their baby. The first days after birth, the first direct eye contact, the first word... - these special events fill parents with happiness and pride.

According to a wonderful decision of the city council, families in the city of Dessau-Roßlau receive the Baby Welcome Package consisting of:

- The welcome allowance in the amount of €125
- A comprehensive information conversation about current offers for families with children aged 0-3 years.

Those entitled to apply are those with custody of the new born baby, who are usually the parents. The prerequisite is that the newly born and newly arrived children are resident in Dessau-Roßlau and have not yet completed their first year of life.

In addition, you will receive a development kit "Your child discovers the world" plus a practical carrying bag as well as a variety of information material.

### **Would you like to benefit from the baby welcome package?**

If so, please make an appointment in advance by calling the Early Intervention Centre (Fachstelle Frühe Hilfen), Ms Schilling, on 0340 2041282.

**The birth certificate of the child and the applicant parent's identity card are required at the appointment.**

You can also make use of the baby welcome package directly at your home in the form of a welcome visit. When you apply for the birth certificate at the local authorities, you will receive a welcome card on which you can state your wish for a welcome visit and give your telephone number. The Welcome Service, Mrs. Uder, will then contact you and arrange an appointment.
